Check artwork rights, geometry, scale, calibration, print settings, and version notes before cutting paper.

1. Rights and source

- ☐ I created this aperture myself
 - ☐ I have permission or a suitable license
 - ☐ The source is public domain and verified

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2. Pattern setup

3. Paper and assembly

- ☐ Paper strips are wide enough for the fold
- ☐ Color order is marked before assembly
- ☐ Numbering reads clearly at print size
- ☐ One small test section was assembled first
- ☐ Final pattern version is stored with the card

4. Print at intended scale

- ☐ Print scale is 100% / Actual Size
 - ☐ Fit to Page and Shrink are disabled
 - ☐ Correct paper size and orientation are selected
 - ☐ Calibration mark measures exactly as labeled
 - ☐ Aperture and numbered pattern align on a test page
- MEASURED CALIBRATION RESULT
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5. Export and version check

- ☐ PDF is the checked print master
- ☐ SVG was inspected in the next tool before editing
- ☐ Filename includes project, geometry, and version
- ☐ Any scale change created a new recorded revision
